Revision #9	1.0 Introduction
	The Chief Engineer is responsible for keeping the vessel in good operating order, maintaining appropriate logs and documentation and ensuring that his engineering staff is competent. Each vessel operated by TDI-Brooks has a set of Chief Engineer's standing orders. Most parts of the Chief Engineer's standing orders will remain the same for each vessel and each Chief Engineer assigned to the vessel. However, it is expected that each assigned Chief Engineer may have modified existing standing orders. It is the responsibility of the Chief Engineer to be comfortable with their standing orders, by either accepting those in place or modifying them. The Chief Engineer must promulgate standing orders. All engine room personnel must acknowledge the engineer's standing orders prior to standing their first watch.
	However, each Chief Engineer must print and post his own standing orders. All engine room personnel must acknowledge the engineer's standing orders by signing them prior to standing their first watch.
