Emergency Radio Messages

Sending a Mayday (distress) message

- Check the radio is switched ON
- Select Channel 16 or 2182 kHz
- Press Transmit button and say slowly and clearly
 - Mayday, Mayday, Mayday
 - This is R/V Brooks McCall Whiskey Charlie Zulu seven eight one one (repeat 3 x)
 - Mayday
 - This is R/V Brooks McCall Whiskey Charlie Zulu seven eight one one
 - My Position Is.... (give latitude longitude or bearing/distance from known point)
 - I am..... (nature of problem on fire, sinking, etc)
 - I require immediate assistance
 - I have(number persons on board, drifting, flares fired, etc)
 - OVER (this means please reply)
- Release transmit button and listen for acknowledgement
- Keep listening Channel 16 for instructions
- If no acknowledgement, repeat the distress call

Types of Messages

"SECURITE"

("say curitay") message concerning safety to navigation or important weather conditions

"PAN PAN"

Urgent message regarding safety of a person or property

"MAYDAY"

Imminent Danger to life or property requiring

immediate assistance
